Re: Métis Nation BC Response to Nova

Dear MNBC CEO, Mr. Drown,

The Nova Métis Heritage Association (Nova) board met this weekend to discuss the situation regarding the registered letter from the Métis Nation BC President of January 25th, 2017 and our multi-page response was prepared and sent in March 1st. I advised the Nova board that to date MNBC President has not formally responded with the exception of your email this past week despite the fact that our Nova response was sent via email on March 7th.

Given the importance of the current situation the Nova Metis board has instructed me to take additional steps to request a formal response and seek a timely clarification from your office at BCMF.

What about our Charter Agreement with Métis Nation BC ??? .Your MNBC President has made complaints; we have given back the answers to all issues. Why the delay to a timely answer from her. MNBC has obligations to us as a Charter Metis Community in good standing. So why the delay?

We want to uphold our position and ensure compliance as necessary from both parties. We state that we have nothing to hide and have done nothing wrong. Please clarify as to what Métis Nation BC intends. A response or a meet with our board immediately or what. We wish to ensure and certify our delegate status at the Métis Nation Governing Assembly? If not, does Métis Nation BC intend to bring this matter to the floor at Métis Nation Governing Assembly?

We remain committed to respecting the Charter agreement signed with MNBC in 2005? Why can't Nova Metis present to the Métis Nation Governing Assembly to address the matter? If so we need to be properly registered as legally delegated participants. Do not deprive us of our legal rights.
