We know today Métis children are being separated from their parents without cause and government lawyers are spending many millions of dollars fighting our Métis families in court while they claim to honour Métis rights.



We have tried diplomacy. We have written letters. We have attended meetings. Government legislation has been written but not followed. Promises have been made and not honored. Pseudo agencies have accepted millions from the government to give the appearance of Métis child protection while the cultural genocide against our people continues. We are taking back control. It is time for action. It is time to bring our children home.
