Construction flagging is a challenging job and needs the utmost attention and care. The Traffic Control Person course is required to be completed prior to becoming a flagger. This course is mandatory and the curriculum is set by the British Columbia Construction Safety Alliance.

CSA approved steel toed boots with ankle support are required during this course.

What Does Training Include:

- 2-day Traffic Control Person course
- Transportation
- Breakfast, lunch and snacks
- Accommodation/dinner if you live outside of Lower Mainland
- Successful graduates are issued a three-year TCP certificate

Training Requirements:

- Must be at least 16 years of age
