What is the Aquatic Habitat Restoration Fund project?

The Aquatic Habitat Restoration Fund is a two year agreement with Fisheries and Oceans. The goal of the project is to research and survey potential areas of concern and follow up with testing, monitoring and aquatic restoration.

Who are the Coastal Water Protectors?

The Coastal Water Protectors are comprised of environmentally concerned BC Métis Federation members residing along the British Columbian coastline. The Coastal Water Protectors receive frequent training on emergency management, spill response and management, environmental monitoring and testing, and marine safety.

Coastal Water Protectors project involvement.

The Coastal Water Protectors receive environmental monitoring, testing and related training on a continual basis. The Coastal Water Protectors survey members of BC Métis Federation to determine area of concern. Focus is then established on those locations for environmental surveying, monitoring, testing and restoration if deemed necessary.

Who is Fisheries and Oceans Canada?

Fisheries and Oceans Canada is a federal institution that is responsible for protecting Canadian waters and managing Canada's fisheries and oceans resources. They help to ensure healthy and sustainable marine ecosystems through the protection of habitats.
