

## Scaffolder

### **Main Responsibilities:**

- Utilizes site drawings and written instructions to select materials required to set ground levels for scaffolds.
- Installs steel pipes, support braces and clamps to form bases for scaffolds.
- Lifts and positions sections of scaffolding and bolts pipes together to build scaffolding as per site requirements.
- Places planks over horizontal bars to create platforms.
- Monitors levels in scaffolding structures to ensure stability.
- Dismantles scaffolding at the completion of a job.
- May perform other related duties as assigned.

### **Job Specific Knowledge:**

- Ability to plan or schedule work based on work scope provided.
- Ability to recognize and address site hazards.

### **Industry Specific Experience:**

- An understanding of safe work practices and the knowledge to safely operate the tools of the trade.
- Able to work outdoors in adverse weather conditions.
- Able to work at heights.

### **Education – Qualifications, Accreditation, Training:**
