In early February, Nadleh Whut'en First Nation and its long-time partner Frost Group, transitioned its Memorandum of Understanding with Macro Pipelines into an Agreement to construct a section of the Coastal GasLink Pipeline. The new partnership is now known as Nadleh-Macro and is currently operating out of the Fraser Lake District. Nadleh-Macro has taken on the Prime Contractor role for the Pipeline Contractor service on the Coastal GasLink WP3 East.

Coastal Gas Link WP3 East pipeline section begins at Row KP 337+326 and extends westerly to KP 440+000.

Job Summary

If you are interested in exploring a labour position on the Project, you are expected to be prepared for work in varying temperatures and terrain. You must be physically fit and able to work with heavy objects, engage in walking, climbing, and being very active all day long.

If you are interested, you are expected to:

- Participate in daily toolbox meetings
- Prepare, Clean and Maintain all site areas
- Install environmental materials
- Install safety signage and traffic signage
- Assist with pipe stringing, bending, and welding activities
- Maintain paperwork or documentation required for all activities
- Traffic Control on the ROW (Right-Of-Way) Spotting and Overhead powerlines
- Communicate and work collaboratively with team members
- Communicate work progress and safety performance to Crew Supervisor
- Knowledge and handling hazardous material and industry waste
- Knowledge of workplace safety requirement and procedures

Shift work is scheduled as 6 Days on with one day of rest, (Monday to Saturday), with Sundays off.

Key Accountabilities

The labourer position is responsible for safe and communicative skills while working with others. Good vision, hand-eye coordination, with knowledge and experience of the pipeline construction industry would be an asset.

Other expectations include.

- Comply with all Health and Safety Requirements tools such as FLHA's, Hazard ID's and WSO's
- Comply with all regulations and legislative requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act for the Province of British Columbia and Environmental standards.
- Operate Hand and Power tools and ensure they are all working safely
- Traffic Control on the ROW (Right-Of-Way) Spotting and Overhead powerlines
