



Nadleh-Macro

In early February, Nadleh Whut'en First Nation and its long-time partner Frost Group, transitioned its Memorandum of Understanding with Macro Pipelines into an Agreement to construct a section of the Coastal GasLink Pipeline. The new partnership is now known as Nadleh-Macro and is currently operating out of the Fraser Lake District. Nadleh-Macro has taken on the Prime Contractor role for the Pipeline Contractor service on the Coastal GasLink WP3 East.

Coastal Gas Link WP3 East pipeline section begins at Row KP 337+326 and extends westerly to KP 391+500. This includes the installation of approximately 54.2 km of pipeline and two Mainline Safety Block Valves.

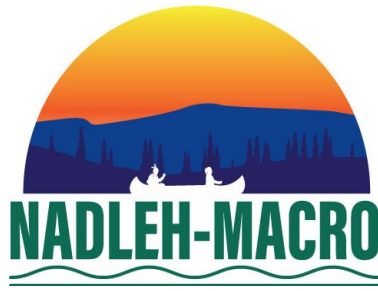

Pipeline Operator

If you are interested in exploring an operator position on the Project, you are expected to:

- Operate various types of heavy equipment to lift, move or place equipment or materials.
- Load and unload equipment.
- Be aware of situation hazards, including blind spots, pinch points, road crossings, power lines, conflicting right-of-way traffic and proper use of tag lines.
- Operate equipment safely in various terrains such as steep slopes.
- Perform Daily safety and maintenance checks.
- Perform routine pre-operation inspection and maintenance on equipment.
- Fill out daily equipment logbooks.
- Clean, lubricate and refuel equipment.
- Communicate with the equipment spotter to discuss hand signals, blind spots etc.

Shift work is scheduled as 6 Days on with one day of rest, (Monday to Saturday), with Sundays off.

Key Accountabilities

The operator position is responsible for safe, steady and reliable operations of the following equipment, not limited to:

- Dozer
 - Rock Truck
 - Grader
 - Excavator
 - Loader
