The 2 Rivers Remix Society is a BC based not-for-profit society. They produce a free moveable feast of contemporary Indigenous music and culture.

They will be in Kamloops July 5th, 6th and 7th at the Kamloops Race Central, 485 Mount Paul Way. This free, family-friendly event will include performances from over 30 Indigenous artists such as DJ Shub, Aysanabee, Tia Wood and many more.
