WCMRC is recruiting for a **Full Time Base Operations Supervisor** to join our team, located in **Beecher Bay, B.C.**

Please note: Initially this role will be based out of our Victoria office, while the new location is under construction.

Our Operations team is comprised of professionals with diverse skills and experience. Their ability to effectively manage and direct spill response procedures within the first few hours after response activation significantly reduces the negative impact oil can have on the surrounding environment.

The Base Operations Supervisors will:

- Organize, plan, schedule and supervise day-to-day operations to support spill response activities as required
- Plan and coordinate training and response readiness exercises, including training of contractors and new operations personnel on the proper use of equipment and vessels.
- Work in accordance with all legal requirements, attend and complete all required health and safety training, report all accidents, and take all necessary precautions to ensure personal safety and the safety of others
- Act as Master of WCMRC vessels when required
- Complete other responsibilities as assigned

To be successful in this role you will possess a minimum Master 60GT or Marine Engineering certificate plus 5 to 7 years of previous marine experience, power equipment maintenance, and working knowledge of local coastlines, along with the completion of a post-secondary degree or diploma, or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Previous supervisory experience is an asset. In addition, you are a collaborative team player with great communication and planning skills, and the ability to work well under pressure and meet multiple deadlines. Other marine certificates, education or experience would be an asset.
